Educational and Rehabilitation Institution of Higher Education Kamianets-Podilskyi State Institute (Kamianets-Podilskyi, Ukraine) represented by the Rector, Professor Maryan TRIPAK, acting on the basis of the Charter on one side, and Lucknow, AKG Global Support Services (OPC) Private Limited, (Uttar Pradesh, India) represented by Mr. Amit Kumar acting on the basis of the Charter, on the other side (hereinafter referred to as the "Parties"), entered into this agreement regarding the following

1. SUBJECT OF THE AGREEMENT

The subject of this agreement is cooperation in the field of scientific research, educational-methodical, organizational, cultural and other activities within the framework of the educational and scientific process.

2. PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

The agreement is concluded with the aim of promoting the development of higher education and science, taking into account the achievements of leading domestic and international schools, as well as to increase the efficiency and quality of the performed research, methodical, teaching and other types of activities of the Parties.

3. DIRECTIONS OF COOPERATION

3.1. Joint participation in international educational and scientific projects.

3.2. Holding scientific, practical scientific conferences, seminars, symposiums, round tables, as well as preparation of scientifically based approaches to solving economic, social and educational problems with the participation of the Parties.

3.3. Creation of joint authors' collectives for the development of monographs, textbooks, manuals, etc.

3.4. The educational component of the agreement is aimed at creating modern principles:

- periodically inform each other about the results of their activities regarding the development of education and economic science in Ukraine and India;
- transfer of educational services, compatibility of bachelor's and master's training programs based on the "Double Diploma" training principle;
- advanced training (internship) of scientific and pedagogical workers;
- academic mobility of education seekers and scientific and pedagogical workers within the framework of formal and informal education;
- conducting guest lectures as an active method of teaching a new level of education;
- promote the publication of scientific and methodical materials;
- exchange scientific, scientific-methodical, educational-methodical literature.

4. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES

4.1. The parties have the right:

- act as initiators of the organization and implementation of scientific, educational and socio-cultural projects;
- on information about the activities of each of the Parties directly related to the subject of this contract.

4.2. The parties undertake to:

- inform the "Parties" about the organization and holding of joint events;
- pedagogical, methodical, and methodological seminars and other forms provided for by the subject of this contract;
- to provide consultations to the "Parties" on the organization and holding of joint events;
- participate in the selection of candidates for participation in joint projects, inform them about the conditions of participation in these events;
- fulfill the terms of this contract.

5. CONDITIONS FOR IMPLEMENTATION AND PROVISION OF JOINT ACTIVITIES

5.1. The results of scientific activity obtained within the framework of this contract are joint intellectual property. The parties have equal rights to use the results of joint

research, which, within the framework of this agreement, are formalized as publications of author collectives.

5.2. The parties inform about their activities related to the performance of scientific research, methodical and other works under this contract.

5.3. None of the Parties shall be liable to the other Party for scientific, educational and economic activities carried out outside the framework of this agreement.

6. TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT

6.1. This agreement does not impose financial obligations on the Parties.

6.2. The term of validity of the agreement is indefinite, until the moment of termination by one of the Parties.

6.3. Changes and additions to this agreement are accepted by written consent of the Parties.

6.4. The agreement is drawn up in two copies (in Ukrainian and in English copy each) for each of the Parties.

6.5. The agreement enters into force from the moment of its signing.

7. SPECIAL CONDITIONS

7.1. For the implementation of this agreement and the determination of specific measures of cooperation in the main areas of activity, the Parties may create working groups under the leadership of persons authorized for this activity on behalf of the Parties.
